SUGGESTIONS.

- 1. This Service is of a religious character, and is intended to promote a worshipful contemplation of the Advent of our Lord.
2. While designed primarily for the Sunday School, it may be used by any religious congregation.
3. No provision is made for scenic or dramatic display. If such accessories are introduced, they should be in keeping with the character of the occasion.
4. Let the whole congregation be encouraged to join in the familiar Hymns (Items 4, 6 and 16).
5. If used in any general religious meeting, the Choruses should be sustained by the Choir.
6. Some of the Responses (e. g. Item 7) may be assigned to individual voices, instead of being rendered in concert.
7. The Responsive Readings may be conducted by the Superintendent, or by different Leaders whom he may select.
8. The Recitations (Items 10 and 15) should be appropriate. They may be omitted.
9. If the first Chorus (Item 2) is used as a Processional, let the stanzas be repeated, without interludes, till all the scholars are in their places.
10. If there is no suitable voice for the Solo (Item 13), let the song be rendered by a Quartette, or by the Choir.
