

York City. She married a third time, June 25, 1806, her kinsman, Archibald Hill, of Philadelphia, by whom she had three children, who died young.\*

Mrs. Hill was the first of the family to adopt the phonetic spelling of her second husband's name, which was afterwards followed by their children.

VII. JAMES McCLARANAN, of Philadelphia, (eldest son of Paul and Margaret McLorinan, or McClaranan,) was born at Woodbury, N. J., January 1, 1802, and died at Philadelphia, January 19, 1869.
