

parted with the remainder of his property at that place, a part of which had been given him by Mr. William Nicholls, and a part inherited from his father, Robert Isbell.*

Eleazer Isbell married, at Killingworth, December 11, 1668, Elizabeth French, and died at the same place September 2, 1677.†

III. ROBERT ISBELL, of Killingworth, Conn., yeoman, (son of Eleazer and Elizabeth,) was born at Killingworth, January 20, 1675 ;§ succeeded to his father's estate at that place, and died February 6, 1717-18,|| bequeathing all his property to his wife, so long as she remained his widow, and directing that when their children came of age she should give them such portions as she thought best. See *Appendix XXXII.* Robert Isbell married, at Killingworth, June 15, 1698,¶ Miriam Carter, who died at the same place, June 23, 1728.**

IV. NOAH ISBELL, of LENOX, Berkshire County, Mass., yeoman, (son of Robert and Miriam,) was born at Killingworth, August 27, 1717,‡‡ and continued to reside there until 1759,§§ when he removed with his wife and children to Salisbury, in Litchfield County, purchasing a farm of 50 acres, being one-half of lot
