

No. 9 of the Town Hill Division, which he sold to Ware Bentou, in 1765.\* In October, 1767, when still residing at Salisbury, he purchased a farm of about 60 acres at Lenox, Mass., adjoining the property in Stockbridge belonging to the heirs of the Rev. Jonathan Edwards,† and shortly afterwards removed to that place, being one of the earliest settlers.

He was received as a member of the Lenox Congregational Church, September 22, 1771, and died October 18, 1801,‡ bequeathing his house, farm, and other property to his son, Nathan Isbell, of Lenox, who was directed to pay certain sums of money to his brothers and sisters. See *Appendix XXXIII*.

Noah Isbell married, at Killingworth, Conn., March 16, 1743, O. S., Jerusha, daughter of Daniel and Jerusha Griswold.§ See that family, *Chapter XXII*.
