

[Armes of Vermandois France: Chequy or & az. Hugh "the Great" or rather his des. added a "chief of France, az. 3 fleurs-de-lys or" The ancient armes of Warrenne are Chequy or and az. It is undoubtedly the Vermandois coat-armor taken by the des. of W'm de Warrenne & Eliz. de Vermandois & borne in Eng. to the present day. (Poynton fam. added—a canton gu. charged with a lion arg. One New Eng. fam. uses armes of Warren of Lon. Gu. a lion arg., a chief chequy or & az. Dover Kent fam. use armes which show no connection with Poynton—"Az. a cross or, bet in chief a martlet & chaplet & in base a chapl. & mart. or. "Richard was of Greenwich Kent" His inherited armes are those of Poynton if des. is correct.

 as well as a most useful citizen) (Jonathan Hatch b. Eng 1626  
 son Moses b. Falmouth 1662 Gen. 1883—Hatch records mention  
 of "Jos. etc" b. 1652, had dau Amy who m Capt D'o of Tolland  
 who had 7 sons & 4 dau (at the time of record that was the number)  
 Recs furnished the compiler "Mary, dau of Lt Jon. D'o (b. etc  
 as bef.) m Joseph Hatch 2d prob abt 1712. He removed to Tolland  
 Waldo "The name of Hatch is associated intimately with settle-  
 ment of the town. One of grantees in first deed fr Windsor com-  
 mittee. Prob. lived Windsor bef 1713, but there is reason to be-  
 lieve he was at Tolland that year and was one of the first two, if  
 not the first, permanent settler there Jonathan D'o (2) having m  
 Amy, (no doubt) sis of Joseph Hatch 2d was induced to leave Dart-  
 mouth by his brother-in-law, 1722 becoming a resident at Tolland.  
 Another proof of Joseph m. a sister of Jonathan 2d is that he named  
 "1st ch. Mercy," & "2d Jonathan" after Mary D'os parents)
