Milton Delano, once a wealthy man, ex-mayor of Denver, Col., and ex-United States consul to Foo Chow, China, is probably dying at his home in New York. The Fidelity & Casualty Co.'s president, George F. Seward, who knew him when he was a rich and influential man, employed him. He was a friend of Generals Grant, Sheridan and Sherman.

Denver, Col., Nov. 23.—M. Delano, Mayor of Denver in 1868 is dying, according to a letter received by Mayor Van Horn; was an Alderman here for a number of years. Under President Grant he was appointed Consul to Foochow China.

New York, March 20.—[Special.]—Mrs. Amelia De Lano, who lives at No. 29 Brooklyn avenue, believes she has fallen heir to a portion of a large estate in France. She recently received a clipping from a Topeka, Kas., paper which states that the Rev. W. E. De Harppart of that city, had just learned, "the American heirs of Chevalier Joseph St. Ledger de Harppart of France were to receive the estate, amounting to 5,000,000 francs." Fourteen heirs were living. Mrs. De Lano also received a clipping from a Denver paper to the effect the De Harppart brothers of that place had fallen heir to part of this estate. Mrs. De Lano says she is a granddaughter of the Chevalier, and the heirs mentioned are great-grandchildren. The Chevalier came to this country and married a daughter of Gen. Thompson of Revolutionary war fame. He afterwards returned taking a son, Louis, with him, and leaving his two other children, Mrs. De Lano's mother and Joseph, here. The Western heirs are the grandchildren of Joseph.
