To Hibbard Delano from Zebulon Delano I shall look for a latter in may or June.”)

(Literal copy of a letter written 1839 age 72 by above to his bro post marked Hartford Vt, directed to Black Hawk Ind. postage 25 cts He was a charter mem. “United Brethren Lodge No 35 F & A M” August 1828 elect. Treas. 1817 was “Overseer of the poor” for Hartford several years. 1816 an association of farmers formed for the purpose of making cider, from a day-book kept by Philemon Hazen of Jerico “Cider Monger” 1819 the share of Zebulon D'o was 26 barrels.
