A. D.)

Wright Jr. 1736-1803 father of Anna; among the first who settled & organized township of Hartford Vt 1762-3 A meeting held at the house of Widow Ruth Strong June 19 1775 Joel Marsh chosen Capt. Benj Wright Jr Lt Co of militia Vt Hist Soc Collect. Vol 2, p 379 gives pay roll of Capt Seth Hodges Co. Col Joseph Marshs Regt of Militia Oct 7-1777, Benj. W. appears 1780 on pay roll of Col John Woods Regt. Capt Joshua Hazen's Co of Militia. Marched to Brookfield alarm of Oct 1780. Pay roll of Co that marched to Bethel fort Aug 1781 Elkanah Sprague Capt Benj a private. These services were for suppression of Indian Vt. frontier outrages N. Y., or N. H. docs may show Rev. service as Vt was claimed by both states)

Sylvester D'o farmer, while young sailed on Lake Champlain 1820 at Painesville O & Apr 2d at Pittsburg Pa. aboard a raft Ohio river, passed by Marietta Apr 6 & Cinn 8th at Louisville Ky 13th worked on turnpike south of do. April 20-1820, for Daniel Waldeton July 20 left there by boat for Cin and with 3 others walked through the woods of Ohio to Detroit Mich. Ter. taken with fever & Ague Oct 6-1820 fr Grosse Isle Mich on board "Commodore Perry" sailing vessel for Buffalo & arrived the eleventh, to Oswego N Y arriving Jan 10-1821, to Richford Not being satisfied concluded to make another trip to aid him procured this certificate

"Richford Vt. July 8-1826. This may certify that we the undersigned inhabitants of Richford, Vermont from personal acquaintance with Sylvester D'o consider him to be a young man of good moral character and safely to be entrusted in any business he may wish to engage in
