Deborah ‘ wrote a fair hand & kept her fathers accounts and correspondence ’ Her father was of a gentle nature and kind to children Capt Henry Delano visited us from Eng 1797 He had been captured by Algerians and in slavery several years, ransomed by the Eng.—He m. Miss Osborne & resides near the ‘ Bell in Edmondton ’ ”
