

The grandsons of the first-named Heinrich Schwarzwald, and at the same time sons of the later alderman, (*rathsherr*,) Johann Schwarzwald, and of his wife Cordula, born Colmer were:

1. Heinrich Schwarzwald, born, on July 9, 1642, married on March 4, 1677, Maria, daughter of Regnier von Hemskirch, by whom he had one son, Johann Schwarzwald, born, on November 9, 1677, and died, on August 27, 1692.

2. Johann Carl Schwarzwald of Bankau, born, on March 12, 1644, married, on December 4, 1687, Sybilla Koenigs. By this marriage there was a son, probably the only one, Johann Carl Schwarzwald, born, on September 11, 1689.

"The family genealogy," as the archivarius of Danzig, Dr. P. Gehrke, writes, "extends to the end of the seventeenth century. I subjoin, from the unpublished book of Dr. G. Loeschins: 'The mayors, (*burgermeisters*,) aldermen, (*rathsherren*,) and judges, (*schoppen*,) of the free-state of Danzig, and the patrician families to which they belonged, Danzig, 1868,' the following particulars given on page 16:

"Of the two sons [of Johann Schwarzwald], Heinrich Schwarzwald died an alderman in 1705. The younger of the two sons, Johann Carl, left a son by the same name, who, a mayor, died, in 1748 (by a fall from a stairway, in his summer-house, at Ohra). With him, the family was extinguished, for his son, Alderman Carl Wilhelm, died before him, in 1747; hence the family in the male line became extinct.

"There was only a daughter of this Carl Wilhelm left, Anna Elizabeth, who married Eduard Friedrich von Conradi. She was the heiress of the estates of Sulmin, Ottomin, Ramkau, Jenkau, Borgfeld, Tiefensee, Nassenhuben, Hochzeit, and Neuenhuben.'" Letter of Magistrate Voss of Danzig, to A. J.
