Memoranda. Jesijntje Swartwout van Vliet united with the church in Maghaghkemeck, on October 16, 1748. Jan van Vliet, her husband, a freeholder of Maghaghkemeck, on July 7, 1728, was appointed on March 7, 1742, by the consistories of the churches of Minissinck and Maghaghkemeck, one of the collectors of money "to aid and build up the Low Dutch churches in the provinces of New York and New Jersey." On September 28, 1762, he was elected an elder in the place of Philip Swartwout. His son Jacobus owned the farm subsequently occupied by his sons, Michael and Solomon van Vliet, which, in 1889, was occupied by their nephew, Solomon van Vliet.

- XXVI. Samuël, son of Thomas and Elisabeth Gordinier Swartwout, baptized in Kingston, on January 22, 1702, married Elisabeth, daughter of Pierre and Esther Hasbroucq Guimar, born on March 22, 1705, and baptized in Kingston, on March 24, 1706. He died about 1782.

Memoranda. Samuel Swartwout died aged eighty years. On October 11, 1750, his wife was received a member of the Reformed Dutch Church at Maghaghkemeck. On the organization of the precinct of Mamakating in 1743, the first precinct meeting was held at his house. The precinct was incorporated into the town of Deerpark, Orange County, in 1798.

On October 15, 1747, he married in Rochester, Ulster County, Antje Westbrook, residing there.
