LXXI. Rachel, daughter of Rudolphus and Elsje Sanders Swartwout, baptized in Loonenberg, (Athens,) Albany County, province of New York, on January 21, 1738, married in New York city, on November 4, 1759, Abraham Sneden of Orange County, a boatman.

LXXIII. Cornelis, son of Rudolphus and Elsje Sanders Swartwout, baptized in Loonenberg, (Athens,) Albany County, province of New York, on April 25, 1744, married in Schraalenburgh, New Jersey, on June 6, 1763, Catlijntje Spier. His widow married, in Schraalenburgh, on February 2, 1793, Thomas Campbell.

Memoranda. He, on November 29, 1770, then residing in Rombout Precinct, Dutchess County, gave a mortgage on land and a house in Rombout Precinct, on the west side and the northwest corner of his brother Dolp's land. In 1776, he was engaged in merchandizing, on Nassau Street, New York, where, that year, his name was registered as a fireman of the city, under the command of Jacobus Stoutenburgh, engineer. In the will of "Cornelius Swartwout of the city of New York, lieutenant of artillery, in the continental service," made on June 14, 1776, he bequeathed to his wife Catharine his house in Chambers Street, and likewise a house in Tens Street. On the institution, in 1783, of the Society of the Cincinnati, he was one of its founders.
