Memoranda. In 1784, Jacobus S. Swartwout moved from Dutchess County to that part of Albany County called on March 7, 1788, the town of Half Moon. On February 5, 1796, James J. Beekman and Theophilus Beekman of the city of New York conveyed to Jacobus S. Swartwout of the town of Half Moon, yeoman, fifty-eight and three-fourth acres of land, part of lot B of the sub-division of lot No. 8 of the eighth allotment of the general partition of Kayaderosseras, for £97 6s 6d. On June 30, 1800, Seth C. Baldwin of Ballston, Saratoga County, New York, conveyed to Jacob S. Swartwout of the town of Half Moon, part of lot No. 1 of the sub-division of lot No. 12 of the eighth general allotment of the patent of Kayaderosseras, containing thirty-four acres, for £52 2s 6d. On April 29, 1806, William Smith conveyed to Jacobus S. Swartwout of the town of Half Moon, part of lot No. 3 of the smaller lot into which lot No. 1 of the sub-division of lot No. 12 of the eighth allotment of the patent of Kayaderosseras, containing thirty-four acres more or less, for \$380. On May 3, 1813, Jacob S. Swartwout of the town of Half Moon, in his will, made that day, names as his living children Hannah, Richard, John, Naomi, Phebe, Francis, Anna, Jane, Peter, and James and appoints his brother Thomas Swartwout and Zebulon Mott his executors. Book of Wills, 3, p. 223, in the office of the surrogate of Saratoga County, N. Y., in Saratoga Springs. His daughter Hannah married — Teachout, and moved to Otsego County, N. Y.; Jane married John Morehouse and moved to Port Byron, N. Y.; Naomi married — Sayles, and died in the town of Half Moon; Peter married Margaret Smith and lived in Middletown, Saratoga County, N. Y.; James J. had a wife Jane — and lived in Saratoga County; and John had a wife Jemima, and died in Clifton Park, Saratoga County.
