

- CXIV. Isaac, son of Jacobus and Aaltje Brinckerhoff Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on December 21, 1767, married Elizabeth Lewis, and died in town of Fishkill, on March 9, 1834.

In an historical sketch by H. D. B. Bailey, published in "The Times" of Fishkill, May 18, 1887, it is related: "Hugh Connor's store was below Johnsville, nearly in front of the residence of Isaac Sherwood. General [Jacobus] then owned the farm, and built this store for his son Isaac, but as he had no taste for mercantile pursuits it was rented to Connor. At the close of the century it was converted into a dwelling house. After the death of Isaac, who inherited the farm, the heirs sold it to Matthew Snook." In his will of October 23, 1823, General Jacobus Swartwout bequeathed to his son Isaac, "the farm south of Fishkill Creek, adjoining the old [Cornelius] Brewer farm and the farm of Benjamin Burroughs."

Isaac Swartwout was appointed on June 23, 1786, a cornet, and on September 30, 1789, a lieutenant in the south brigade of Dutchess County militia.

- CXV. Jacobus J., son of Jacobus and Aaltje Brinckerhoff Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on June 26, 1770, and baptized in Hackensack, married in Fishkill, on February 19, 1801, Anna R. Seward, born on January 24, 1778, and died March 30, 1868. He died, on January 16, 1846, without offspring. Their graves in the church burial-ground at Hopewell are marked by a marble monument. The house in which Mrs. Swartwout died is still standing, but unoccupied, in Swartwoutville. In his will, dated October 23, 1823, General Jacobus Swartwout bequeathed to his son, Jacobus J., "the farm purchased of David Barkins, and also the meadow land purchased of William B. Alger."

- CXVI. Aaltje, daughter of Jacobus and Aaltje Brinckerhoff Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, on November 30, 1773, and baptized on January 21, 1774, married in Fishkill, on March 29, 1800, John A., son of Abraham and Ariantje Elmendorf Sleight, baptized in Kingston, on June 1, 1700. He died in the town of Fishkill, on December 6, 1841, and she died in Kingston, on August 2, 1859.

General Jacobus Swartwout, in his will of October 23, 1823, bequeathed to his daughter, Aaltje, wife of John A. Sleight, the farm on which the general was then living.

- CXVIII. Annatje, daughter of Gerardus and Maria Oosterhout Swartwout, baptized in Marblctown, Ulster County, province of New York, on June 12, 1757, married in Maghaghkemeck, Ulster County, on November 29, 1771, Samuel Depui.

- CXX. Jacobus, son of Philip and Antje Wynkoop Swartwout, baptized in Maghaghkemeck, Ulster County, province of New York, on November 18, 1750, married in Maghaghkemeck, on May 12, 1771, Jannetje Davids. She died about 1780. He married second, Jannetje, daughter of Benjamin Hoornbeek.
