

Bayles, born in New Jersey in 1830. She died in Brooklyn, N. Y., on October 25, 1861, and her body was interred in Sleepy Hollow Cemetery, at Tarrytown, N. Y.

Memoranda. Maria Eliza died unmarried in New York city, July 19, 1887; Julia Frances died also unmarried, in Tarrytown, October 25, 1866. She valued highly the different papers, letters, and books relating to the service of her grandfather, Colonel Barnardus Swartwout, in the war of the Revolution, and in her will she directed that "the orderly book and all the papers relating to Colonel Barnardus Swartwout, together with his journal," should be given to the New York Historical Society. Cornelia Augusta married in New York city, June 23, 1835, Thomas Milton Clark, born in Danby, Tompkins County, N. Y., September 27, 1809, and died in Brooklyn, March 18, 1878.

CCCLVI. Eudora, daughter of John and Mary Smith Swartwout, born in the city of New York, N. Y., on September 27, 1798, married in St. Augustine, Florida, on March 24, 1828, James M. Glasell, born in Virginia, and died on November 3, 1838. She died in 1875.

They were the parents of one child, who died in infancy.

Memoranda. James M. Glasell was appointed ensign in the Twentieth Regiment of Infantry on May 1, 1812; second lieutenant on April 16, 1813; first lieutenant on July 12, 1814; transferred to Fourth Regiment of Infantry on May 17, 1815; appointed captain on February 10, 1818; major assistant adjutant-general from May 22, 1818, to June 1, 1821; major of Sixth Regiment of Infantry on September 6, 1837. *Brevet Rank*: Brevet-Major on February 10, 1828, for ten years' faithful service in one grade.
