Memoranda. Lorenzo Barnardus Swartwout was graduated from the academy at Poughkeepsie, Vt., at the age of twenty-one years. Subsequently taught school at Cape Girardeau. Later he resided in New Orleans, La., where he was stricken with yellow fever. On his recovery he settled at Glens Falls, and engaged largely in the lumber business. In March, 1867, he moved with his family to Three Rivers, Michigan, where he continued in the lumber business, and in 1876 founded the Three Rivers Manufacturing Company. His son, Albert H., died at Glens Falls, October 25, 1865, and Herbert J. at the same place, July 24, 1866.
