At the end of the war, he engaged in merchandizing and farming in Illinois, until November, 1882, when he accepted a position as clerk in the United States Treasury Department, in Washington, D. C., in which he still remains. His daughter, Edith Lela, died in Washington, D. C., September 5, 1892.
