Memoranda. On April 27, 1665, Roeloff Swartwout, then thirty years of age, was registered a student of medicine at the University of Leyden. On September 22, 1665, he was graduated a doctor of medicine, at the University of Harderwyck. In 1669, he was residing on the *Brouwersgracht*, Amsterdam. His son Herman was registered, on August 26, 1687, a student at the University of Leyden.

- XIV. Abraham, son of Herman and Geertruijt Schutte Swartwout, born in the city of Amsterdam, Holland, in 1645, and baptized there, on December 15, 1647, married in Amsterdam, on November 17, 1671, Barbara, daughter of Barbara Otho Outhuys, twenty years old, living on the new side of the city, back of the city-wall, (*achterburgwal*).

Memoranda. On April 27, 1665, Abraham Swartwout was registered a student of philosophy at the University of Leyden. In 1671 he was a merchant, (*koopman*), residing on the *Brouwersgracht*, Amsterdam. On February 19, 1672, he was declared a born freeman (*een ingeboren poorter*) of the city.

- XVI. Floris, son of Herman and Geertruijt Schutte Swartwout, born in the city of Amsterdam, Holland, in 1646, married there on December 23, 1670, Sara, daughter of Cristoffel Spoelders, twenty-four years old, living on the old side of the city, back of the city wall, (*oude-zijde achterburgwal*). On December 3, 1673, he married in Amsterdam, Elisabeth Hendrix, an orphan, nineteen years old, living on *Leitsestraat*. She surviving him married Herman Haakman. During her second widowhood, she lived on the *Singel*, and died, in Amsterdam, August 12, 1739.

- XX. Hendrik, son of Floris and Elisabeth Hendrix Swartwout, born in Amsterdam, Holland, in 1675, and married, there, on June 7, 1699, Catryna, daughter of Arent Arentsz van Sons, eighteen years old, living on the inner side, (*binnen-kant*).

Memoranda. On April 19, 1698, he was declared a born freeman of the city of Amsterdam. In his life-time he was a dealer in paints and oils, (*een verfverkooper*), and in 1699 was residing on the Velvet city-wall (*Fluwelburgwal*).
