## MEMORANDA.

The father of Jane Wemple (Wimple), the wife of John Starin, was Hendrick Wemple of Holland. He was born in 1720, and, emigrating to America, became one of the twelve proprietors of Schenectady township, or Manor of Schenectady, as it was at that time called. He lived in Charlestown (at that time in Tryon county, N. Y.), opposite Caughnawaga on the Mohawk river. He was a man of large-landed property, owning 1,000 acres at what is now Cooperstown, N. Y., 1,000 acres of the "Stone Heap Patent," in Charlestown, N. Y., and 1,000 acres at Schroon Lake,\* now in Essex county, N. Y. He also owned the Island of Menawald, given him for services rendered as Indian interpreter to Generals Herkimer and Sullivan.
