MEMORANDA.

John Fluskey, the husband of Charity Staring, was a gallant officer in the War of 1812. In the early part of that contest he served as first lieutenant of a troop in a squadron of the Fifth Division of U. S. Cavalry, and at the time of his death he was major of the third squadron of the Sixth Regiment of U. S. Cavalry. His lieutenant's commission, dated May 1, 1807, bears the signature of Gov. Morgan Lewis, and his major's, dated April 22, 1814, that of Gov. Daniel D. Tompkins. These commissions are now in possession of his granddaughter, Mrs. Emelio
