**Philip F. Starin**, son of Frederick (22), was born on the 12th of May, 1775. He died August 2, 1798, unmarried.

**Jacob F. Starin**, son of Frederick (22), was born at Charleston (Glen), N. Y., on the 20th of June, 1785. He was married in that village, on the 22d of December, 1804, to Harriet Schermerhorn, who was born at Schodack, N. Y., on the 8th of June, 1788. He died at Fultonville, N. Y., May 9, 1828. At the time of his death he held the office of elder in Rev. Abraham Van Horn's church. His comparatively early death was caused by an acute attack of dyspepsia, doubtless brought on by his changing the active and laborious life of a farmer for that of a "tavern-keeper," as all proprietors of houses of entertainment were then called. He survived this change in his occupation only three years, and but for it he would probably have lived—judging by the advanced lives of others of the family—forty years longer. His remains were subsequently removed to White Water, Wis., where they now rest beside those of his wife, who was living at that village with her son, Frederic, at the time of her decease, an event which occurred on the 22d of January, 1869.
