MEMORANDA.

Sylvanus Seaman's first wife was a direct descendant of Roger Williams of Providence Plantation, R. I., and of John Morton, one of the "Signers." Her father, William Williams, founded the village of Fredonia, N. Y. ; and two of her brothers were present, as volunteers, at Perry's victory on Lake Erie. In this action, one was killed outright on the *Niagara*, and the other, wounded on the *Lawrence*, died subsequently of his wounds. His first wife's eldest sister, Esther Williams, married Sherman P. Whalley, a direct descendant of Edward Whalley, the "Regicide," who, on fleeing to this country, was hidden in a cave near New Haven by William Leete, at that time the Royal Governor of Connecticut. One of Colonel Stone's best stories is founded on this incident.
