**Frederic Jacob**, son of Jacob F. (58), was born at Glen, N. Y., on the 17th of April, 1821. His profession was that of canal and railroad engineering and land surveying until 1872, though previous to his adopting that profession as his life work, seven years were passed by him in learning the science of rudimentary agriculture in the Valley of the Mohawk. Since the year 1872, his business has been altogether in connection with the land department of the Canada and North-west Railroad Company at Chicago. He is, like his second cousin, John Henry (169), a gentleman of fine presence, having a striking "Starin" physiognomy. He resides (1892) at White Water, Wis. He was married at Glen, N. Y., August 24, 1843, to Jane Maria Groat. She was born April 25, 1821, and was a daughter of John Groat of Glen, N. Y., and a niece of the first wife of Joseph (68).
