Matthew Starin, son of Adam (59), was born at Frankfort, N. Y., on the 13th of September, 1811, and moved to Horseheads, N. Y., in 1852. His occupation was that of a farmer; but he was also a justice of the peace for several years, and held from time to time other offices of trust and responsibility; filling all of them to the thorough satisfaction of his constituents. He was, moreover, personally, highly esteemed by all who knew him, and his acquaintance was a very wide one. He was married, in 1838, by Edward Davis, a justice of the peace at Frankfort, N. Y., to Adeline Lincoln, a daughter of Colonel Joseph Lincoln of German Flats, N. Y., and a lineal descendant of Stephen Hopkins, one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. She was born October 14, 1816, at Warren, N. Y., and died in Horseheads, December 21, 1887. Mr. Starin resided until his
