Myndert William Starin, son of Henry Wemple (67), was born at Esperance, Schoharie county, N. Y., on the 22d of November, 1818, and was married, by the Rev. Charles G. Somers, to Laura Littlefield, daughter of Ira and Sarah Mitchell Floyd of New York city, on the 15th of October, 1845. When a young man he went to Syracuse and engaged in business with his father, and in 1852 entered the employ of the New York Central railroad in that city. When the Lake Shore road was opened, he became its general freight agent at Buffalo, remaining there four years. In 1857 he came to New York and engaged in the commission business at No. 98 Park Place, where he continued until his death, which occurred at the residence of his son-in-law, Mr. George Moser (No. 8 Monroe street, Brooklyn), on the 29th of March, 1892. He is buried by the side of his wife in Cypress Hills Cemetery. He had lived in Brook-
