John Henry Starin, son of Myndert (69), was born at Sammons ville, N. Y., August 27, 1825, and was baptized by Dominie Abram Van Horn, so long the beloved pastor of the old Caughnawaga church. His father and mother were married in 1816, by Rev. Dominie Van Horn—the latter baptizing all her children. When quite young, he was sent to the primary department of the district school, where he mastered the rudimentary branches of a classical education, which was continued at the Academy of Esperance, N. Y. It was while here, and while study-
