

Samuel Judd removed from the old homestead on Pleasant St., Northampton, and resided in a house on the road leading to Eastampton. He was a farmer. Abigail (Alvord) Judd was named in her father's estate as having received her share previous to his death. She was deranged some years and it became necessary to confine her.

ELIZABETH ALVORD (*Benjamin, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., Sept., 1693; died Northampton, Mass., July 18, 1768; married Northampton, Mass., Jan. 24, 1712, Preserved Bartlett, son of Samuel and Sarah (Baldwin) Bartlett. He was born Northampton, Mass., Aug. 29, 1689; died Northampton, Mass., Feb. 21, 1762. Res. Northampton, Mass. Children: (All born at Northampton, Mass.)

Elizabeth (Alvord) Bartlett is named in the settlement of her father's estate as having received her share previous to his death.

"Preserved Bartlett's wife, sister of Benjamin Alvord, was crazy some years, was confined at times by chains, escaped from house one day and could not be found. An alarm was made, the drums beat and the bell rung. She was found dead in Mill River, down below the pastures, July 18, 1768. Her husband took her with him to collect a tax of Bernard Bartlett. Bernard's wife, who was reputed to be a witch, complained about the tax and told him he would be sorry for collecting it. He believed that his wife's insanity was caused by Bernard's wife's witchery and his son Benjamin believed the same." (Judd Manuscript.)

Preserved Bartlett's grandfather, Robert Bartlett, was killed by the Indians at Northampton, Mass., Mar. 14, 1676.

19. BENJAMIN ALVORD (*Benjamin, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., Sept., 1695; died Northampton, Mass., Oct. 22, 1772; married 1st about 1726, Eunice King, daughter of Joseph and Mindwell (Pomeroy) King. She was born Northampton, Mass., Mar. 12, 1703; died Northampton, Mass., Oct. 8, 1732.

He married 2nd Northampton, Mass., Jan. 17, 1733, Ruth Alexander, daughter of Nathaniel and Hannah (Allen) Alexander. She was born Northampton, Mass., Feb. 22, 1691; died Northampton, Mass., June 6, 1770. Res. Northampton, Mass. Children:
