

1st, Apr. 14, 1768, Prudence Stevens. He married 2nd, Mrs. Susannah Page. She died Hartland, Vt., Sept. 12, 1783. He married 3rd, Speedy Bramble, widow of Abel Bramble of Hartland, Vt. Res. Windsor, Vt., Charlestown, N. H., and Hartland, Vt. No children.

Simeon Alvord was a man of property. He owned real estate in Windsor, Hartland and Hartford, Vt. He owned in Windsor a house, shop, bark mill, mill stones, vats for tanning, etc.

An aged Christian lady of Hartland, who was acquainted with him when she was a child, says:

"Mr. Simeon Alvord was a good, candid Christian and was much esteemed for his counsel. He was naturally very cheerful, and was very good company; but he would often censure himself for being so lively. He often, with tears, would say how much he regretted the manner of spending his life in his younger days. He was uncommonly gifted in prayer. I not only loved to hear him talk but I loved to hear him pray."

The U. S. census shows that he was living in Hartland, Vt., from 1790-1810. His property fell to the children of his last wife by a former husband.

Mrs. Susannah Alvord was a sincere Christian and Mrs. Speedy Alvord was a member of the Baptist Church.

85. HANNAH ALVORD (*Noah, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Springfield, Mass., Mar. 5, 1727-8; died May 8, 1816; married, 1790, Ebenezer Bliss, son of Ebenezer and Joanna (Lamb) Bliss. He was born Dec. 7, 1725; died Mar. 2, 1808. Res. Springfield, Mass. No children.

86. MOSES ALVORD (*Noah, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Springfield, Mass., Mar. 20, 1730-31; married Springfield, Mass., Dec. 24, 1761, Ann Cadwell, daughter of Daniel and Mary (War-riner) Cadwell. She was born Springfield, Mass., Mar. 19, 1735. Res. Wilbraham, Mass. No children.

March 23, 1759, Noah Alvord of Springfield, Yeoman, conveyed to Moses Alvord part of his home-lot on the east side of Conn. River in Springfield.

May 30, 1776, Aaron Alvord of Wilbraham, Mass., conveyed to Moses Alvord of Wilbraham land in Wilbraham.

87. AARON ALVORD (*Noah, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Springfield, Mass., July 29, 1734; married Springfield, Mass., Jan. 15, 1761, Orpha Day, daughter of Samuel and Martha (Stebbins) Day. She was born Springfield, Mass., May 21, 1734. Res. Wilbraham, Mass., and Amherst, Mass. No children.
