U. S. census of 1790 states that Jonathan Alvord was head of a family in Westhampton, Mass. There were two males in the family and four females. He left a will dated Mar. 18, 1826. Mrs. Free-love Alvord was admitted to the Westhampton church Nov. 15, 1827. She married 2nd, at Easthampton, Aug. 27, 1829, John Taylor.

Rev. War Service: "Alvord, Jonathan, Northampton, Private, Capt. Jonathan Allen's Co., Col. John Fellows' Reg. Muster roll dated Aug. 1, 1775. Enlisted May 1, 1775; service 3 mos. 1 week, 1 day. Also Co. return dated Dorchester, Oct. 7, 1775. Also order for bounty coat or its equivalent in money, dated Camp at Dorchester, Nov. 15, 1775. Also Capt. Oliver Lyman's Co. Enlisted Aug. 17, 1777; service 7 days. Marched on an alarm to East Hoosac."

"Alverd, Jonathan, Private, Capt. Kirkland's Co., Col. Ruggles Woodbridge's Reg. Enlisted Aug. 16, 1777; dis. Nov. 29, 1777; service 3 mos. 22 days. Company raised to re-enforce the Northern Army." (Mass. Soldiers in Rev.)
