RACHEL ALVORD (*Thomas, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born Guilford, Conn., Apr. 17, 1733; died Middletown, Conn., buried Jan. 7, 1768; married Middletown, Conn., Oct. 18, 1750, Stephen Blake, son of Jonathan and Mary (Johnson) Blake. He was born Middletown, Conn., Feb. 18, 1730; died Middletown, Conn., Jan. 6, 1767. Res. Middletown, Conn. Children:

Stephen Blake and his son Jonathan were drowned the evening "after Jan. 6," 1767 in Mill Brook. The Middletown church records state that Mrs. Rachel Blake died of a "lingering difficulty."
