136. ANNA ALVORD (*Seth, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born East Hampton, Conn.; married East Hampton, Conn., Mar. 31, 1785, Samuel Caswell.

Joseph Caswell, Jr., in 1820, took his father from East Hampton, Conn., to Burlington, N. Y., or Exeter, N. Y., to live with him. Possibly Samuel Caswell moved there also.

137. HUET ALVORD (*Seth, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born East Hampton, Conn., 1757; died East Hampton, Conn., May 27, 1787; married East Hampton, Conn., June 16, 1785, Joanna Hills, daughter of John and Mindwell (Wright) Hills. She was born East Hampton, Conn., Mar. 9, 1763; died East Hartford, (Burnside), Conn., Apr. 21, 1831. Res. Chatham (East Hampton), Conn. Child:

333. John Huet, bapt. East Hampton, Conn., July 15, 1787; probably d. young.

Mrs. Joanna Alvord owned the covenant in East Hampton, Conn., July 15, 1787. She married 2nd, Oct. 17, 1792, Stephen Burnham of East Hartford, Conn.

Rev. War Service: "Alvord, Hewitt, Private, Capt. Warner's Co., 3rd Reg. of the Line. Enlisted Apr. 25, 1777; term 3 years; dis. Apr. 25, 1780. This regiment was raised for the new army or "Continental Line" and recruited in Hartford Co. and the eastern part of the state. Assisted in repelling the enemy at Danbury, Apr. 26-27, camp at Peekskill, May, 1777, under Putnam along the Hudson. At West Point began permanent construction works, at White Plains, engaged in storming Stony Point, 1779." (Conn. men in the Rev.)

139. ELIZABETH ALVORD (*Seth, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born East Hampton, Conn.; died Hebron, Conn., Dec. 19, 1795; married East Hampton, Conn., May 1, 1783, Samuel Fielding, son of Samuel and Mary (Mott) Fielding. He was born Hebron, Conn., Jan. 22, 1753; died Marlboro, Conn., Mar. 25, 1818. Res. Hebron (now Marlboro), Conn. Children:
