

184. LYDIA ALVORD (*Nathan, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born Apr. 25, 1762; died about 1789; married South Hadley, Mass., Jan., 1785, Enos Kellogg, son of Jabez and Abigail (Catlin) Kellogg. He was born South Hadley, Mass., July 28, 1761; died Enosburg, Vt. Res. Hanover, N. H., Shelburne, Mass., and Lebanon, N. H. Children:

Enos Kellogg was a Revolutionary soldier and witnessed the execution of Major Andre. He was a weaver by occupation and went to Hanover, N. H., about 1784. In 1791 he returned to Shelburne, Mass.; afterwards went to Hanover, N. H., Montpelier, Vt., and Enosburg, Vt. He married for his second wife, Demis Wells, Oct. 10, 1792, at Shelburne, Mass. By her he had several children.
