William Alvord migrated to Vt. about 1793 and settled in Rutland. Col. James Claghorn, father of Mrs. William Alvord, was born July 30, 1739, at Salisbury, Conn., emigrated thence to Rutland, Vt. about 1773, and died there June 13, 1813. He was a volunteer under Stark in the Battle of Bennington and distinguished for his gallantry in that engagement.
