Northampton, Mass., Sept. 22, 1754; died Northampton, Mass., June 22, 1833; married Northampton, Mass., about 1779, Maria Judd, daughter of Samuel and Mercy (Hanchet) Judd. She was bapt. Northampton, Mass., Feb. 16, 1755; died Northampton, Mass., Oct. 6, 1810. Res. Northampton, Mass. (South Harbour near Smith's Ferry). Children:
