"Dea. Levi Platt went from Danbury to Winchester when a boy with Joseph Elmer of whom he learned the blacksmith's trade. He was a schoolmaster in his early manhood and in 1790 he bought of Martin Hurlburt land now composing part of the farm of Harvey Andrews on which he lived until about 1794 when he bought and occupied during his remaining life the farm which was later owned by his son, Sylvester Platt, Esq. Dea. Platt was a Puritan of the Puritans, firm as the everlasting hills in his political and religious principles and withal a man of humble and sincere piety, faithful to every duty as a father, church member and citizen of the town. He succeeded his father in law, Eliphaz Alvord, as town clerk, registrar and deacon in the Cong. Church. He was a member of the Conn. Constitutional Convention of 1818." (Boyd's Annals of Winchester.)

LOIS ALVORD (*Eliphaz, Jonathan, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born East Hampton, Conn., Mar. 4, 1771; died Winchester, Conn., Apr. 20, 1840; married Winchester, Conn., Jan. 6, 1795, Levi Ackley, son of Thomas and Sarah (Luther) Ackley. He was bapt. East Hampton, Conn., July 24, 1768; died Tyringham, Mass., Nov. 10, 1817. Res. Winchester, Conn. No children.

Levi Ackley was of Chatham, Conn., and went to Winchester, Conn., about 1793. He owned and lived on a farm on the East side of Long Lake now owned by John F. Rockwell. He removed to Tyringham, Mass., in 1807 where he died.
