392. **PLINY ALVORD** (*Caleb, Elijah, John, Thomas Alexander*), born Greenfield, Mass., Mar. 13, 1781; died Troy, O., Dec. 5, 1859; married Sept. 1, 1808, Laurana Bardwell, daughter of Samuel and Editha (Gunn) Bardwell. She was born Montague, Mass., April. 25, 1786; died Greenfield, Mass., Dec. 21, 1865. Res. Montague, Mass., and Troy, O. Children.

395. **MELINDA ALVORD** (*Caleb, Elijah, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born Greenfield, Mass., May 13, 1785; died Cambridge, Mass., Dec. 15, 1846; married Greenfield, Mass., July 28, 1805, Joseph T. Buckingham, son of Nehemiah and Mary (Huntington) Tinker. (His name was changed by General Court of Mass. in May, 1804, from Joseph Buckingham Tinker to Joseph T. Buckingham). He was born Windham, Conn., Dec. 21, 1779; died Cambridge, Mass., Apr. 11, 1861. Res. Boston and Cambridge, Mass. Children:

a. Joseph Huntington, b. Boston, Mass., Aug. 20, 1806; d. Lancaster, N. H., May 12, 1880; mar. Oct. 30, 1827, Eliza Willett. He engaged in newspaper work in early life, afterwards studied law and practiced in Lancaster, N. H.

b. Melinda Alvord, b. Boston, Mass., June 13, 1808; d. Sept. 15, 1878; mar. June 10, 1834, Samuel Edwin Robbins.

c. Edwin, b. Boston, Mass., June 26, 1810; d. May 18, 1832 of consumption on the brig "Mermaid" on his return voyage from Smyrna. He was educated at the English High School in Boston, became a printer and afterwards was associated with his father in the publication of the New England Magazine and Boston Courier.

d. Edgar, b. Boston, Mass., Aug. 19, 1812; d. Deerfield, Mass., Apr. 29, 1894; mar. Troy, N. Y., June 5, 1855, Sally Ann Merritt Hart. He was educated at the Boston Latin School and Harvard Col-
