The following is Mrs. Velina Searl's (b. 1815) recollection of the migration from Mass. to Ohio:

"The trip from Northampton to Painesville, O., where we stopped for the winter, was made wholly by horse and wagon and ox-team. It occupied six weeks. The road was quite good most of the way, but from Painesville to Hinckley it lay through the forest, marked only by chopped trees. At the taverns where we stopped for the night we had to furnish our own beds, making them up on the floor, and also do our own cooking in the common kitchen. No exciting incidents."

Joshua Kellogg was a farmer and one of the earliest settlers in Hinckley, O. In the Kellogg family is the old family Bible of Timothy Alvord, with many Northampton records between the dates 1800—1815.
