Daniel B. Alvord followed the occupation of farming. He served several years as justice of the Peace both at Quincy and Sherburne, Minn. After his marriage he moved to Hamilton, N. Y., thence in succession to Floyd, Boonville, Catteraugus Co., and Buffalo, where he lived four years. From here in 1848 he removed to Utica, Mich., thence to Wis., where he bought land, but gave it up after a short time and went to Roscoe, Ill. for a year, then to Iowa for five years. In 1857 he removed to Minn. and settled in Quincy, Olmstead Co., where he remained ten years. Since that time the family has lived in Lake Belt, Martin Co. Mrs Sarah (Holmes) Alvord is still living (1908) with her son.
