

Here he engaged in mercantile business with his oldest son and also practiced his profession as a physician. With the breaking out of the "Gold Fever" in California in 1849, he set out for the gold fields. After two years he returned to his home for a visit, but soon sought again the distant Cal., accompanied by his eldest son. An absence of two years found him home again, engaging in his former occupation and profession. He was a member of the Cong. church and cherished its principles with great fidelity.
