In 1848 Elisha Alvord went to Lansingburgh, N. Y., to live with his aunt Julia V. Bissell. He lived with her until 1850 when he returned to Syracuse and lived with his father, who had remarried. In 1852 he entered Mt. Pleasant Ins., Amherst, Mass., where he remained two years, then returning to live with his father until 1866, in which year he married and went to New York City to live. He was a clerk in the New York P. O. in 1871. In 1873 he took a position in the Dept. of Public Works, New York City, which he held until 1876 when he entered the Health Dept. Losing this position through political changes he re-entered the P. O. in 1878; was transferred to the mail service in 1880, resigned in 1881 and re-entered the Health Dept., where he remained until 1883, when he went to Tex. Leaving Tex. in 1885 he went to Kan. and practiced law in Reece (In 1862-3 he had studied law with the firm Sedgwick, Andrews and Kennedy, Syracuse, N. Y., and at the Albany Law School in 1864-65). In 1887 he went to La Junta, Col., and was librarian for the A. T. & S. S. R. R. Co., until 1890. He held the office of Judge in the county in 1893, having previously been Judge of Probate. In 1897 he went to Denver, in 1898 to Pueblo, Col., where he was a court officer in the Pueblo Co. Court. His wife secured a divorce from him in 1878 and remarried. She now resides in California. He is in Alabama at present time, 1908.
