LIEUT. HENRY KINGMAN⁵ (*Henry,⁴ Henry,³ John,² Henry¹*), son of Henry and Mary (Allen) Kingman, was born in the North Parish of Bridgewater (now Brockton), Mass., June 29, 1735. He married MARY KEYZER, June 25, 1761. He was a lieutenant in the militia. This family resided on the farm afterward occupied by the late Deacon Jacob Fuller, and later sold to the town of North Bridgewater, and for many years occupied as a "Town Farm," in the east part of that town. The wife died May 3, 1811, aged 82 years. The husband died March 3, 1830, aged 96 years. Both are buried in the "Thompson Cemetery" on Summer Street, Brockton.
