10 Stephen Twining, son of **5** Stephen, b. Feb 20, 1719, Bucks Co., Pa.; d. Sept. 3, 1777, B. In 1761, Aug. 14, he bought a farm of 118 acres of Jno. Kerboah, in Springfield, Pa., for £ 601, where he probably for a time lived; m. Sarah Jansey (wid. with two chil.) 1773. The wid. whose maiden name was Worth, m. James Bunson, 1782, son of Joseph of Springfield.

11 Samuel Twining, son of **6** Nathaniel; b. Jan. 24, 1726, Newtown, Pa., on the large and productive farm now (1885) owned by Joseph Klette, just outside of the Borough limits. The farm north and adjoining was owned by his brother, **12** Benjamin. m. *Mary Jenks, daughter of Thomas and Mercy (Wildman) Oct. 26, 1752. She was b. April 20, 1733; d. 1803. The Middletown M. M.
