

37 Judah Twining, son of **18** Elijah, b. Jan. 21, 1774, E.; d. Aug. 27, 1854, Tolland; m. Catharine Fowler, Nov. 19, 1806; d. May 19, 1844, aged 67 yrs. A very benevolent man; devoted member of Cong. Ch.; noted for his fat cattle and hogs. Col. Samuel Pickett worked for him one summer. Always walked with two canes, owing to numerous corns upon the bottoms of his feet.
