

1. Jane E., b. July 2, 1835; m. *first*, Theo. Thomas, who was drowned in Wis. river; m. *secondly*, Elijah Twining, son of 45 John, Feb. 23, 1864; m. *thirdly*, Fulton L. Miner, M'ch 7, 1866; res. Cedar City, Mo.; 6 or 7 chil.
2. Sophia, b. Nov. 19, 1837; m. Phineas Walker, Nov. 26, 1857; res. Lancaster, Wis.; chil.
- 3.—Thomas, b. Dec. 16, 1815; m. *first*, Udora Walker about 1842, Erie Co., N. Y. They separated and he married again, Jane Morgan, and settled in Warren Co., Pa.; res. Russell; farmer. *Issue* by first wife:

- 7.—Mary S., b. Dec. 11, 1823; m. Amandus Sherwood, April, 1856; resided at Marshall, Dane Co., Wis., where they both died, 1857; no chil.

**47** Thomas Twining, son of **23** Thomas; b. Jan. 13, 1801, Quakertown, N. J.; m Sarah, dau. of \*Ben. and Rachel Kester, Sept. 27, 1820; b. Dec. 19, 1799; d. near Huntington, Ind., Dec. 5, 1843

\*Ben. Kester, who m. Rachel, dau. of Stephen and Hannah Hambleton, was a son of Samuel Kester, b. Sept. 26, 1737; d. M'ch 8, 1804, and of Susan Webster, his wife, b. Oct. 11, 1736; d. Feb. 24, 1832.

Of Samuel Kester, we learn from the *Hambleton Genealogy* that one dau., Sarah, m. Joseph Palmer, of Chester Co., Pa., and a dau., Susannah, m. Joseph Stevenson; lived at Rahway, N. J., and d. there a few years since in her 99th year.

He was of German descent, lived near Quakertown, N. J., and he and his family were prominent members of that Monthly Meeting.

"Skinner Webster, who m. Jane, a sister of Rachel above mentioned, and several Websters, who moved to Erie Co., N. Y., and there intermarried with Hambletons, were closely related to Susannah Webster above named."
