“Jessy Hager, son of John Hager, was granted the first charter for a horse car route in the city of New Brunswick, New Jersey. His death left it in court in Middlesex County until it was annulled to make way for the present charter in 1880-1881 which is now used for the electrical railway of the present day.”
