Arms—Arg., on a pile vert three pears stalked and leaved or, impaling, in right of his wife, the arms of KNIGHT, viz., gu., two lions rampant in fess and within a bordure arg. a canton erm. thereon a spur or. **Crest**—A gryphon sejant wings elevated or, the wings fretty vert and resting the dexter claw upon a masle gold. **Motto**—Recte agens confide.

Seat—Bitham House, Avon Dassat, near Leamington.
