

12. JOHN⁴ WHITE (*Isaac,³ John,² John¹*), a merchant of Charlestown, moved to Billerica, Mass., with his mother Rebecca after the breaking out of the Revolution; died in Billerica November 23, 1811. His will, dated August 16, 1804, and codicil dated January 11, 1808, were probated in Middlesex County Dec. 12, 1812. By the will and codicil he gave to his daughter, Anna Orne, then a widow, one third of his real and personal estate; to his daughter Mary, the wife of John Brown, one third, and the other third to his two grandchildren, Sarah White and Mary Henley White, daughters of his son Isaac, deceased. At the time his estate was settled Sarah had married John Pickering, Esq., of Salem, and Mary Henley had married Rev. Samuel Gile of Milton. He married 1st, Mary Henley, November 5, 1741; married 2d, April 25, 1765, widow Mary Breed. Children:-

13. JOSEPH⁴ WHITE (*Benjamin,³ Joseph,² John¹*), lived in Brookline; selectman 1756 and 1758; died August 19, 1777; married May 26, 1730, Sarah, daughter of Ebenezer Crafts of Roxbury, born March 30, 1710; died 1776. Children were:

14. BENJAMIN⁴ WHITE (*Benjamin,³ Joseph,² John¹*), of Brookline, one of the selectmen several years; died 1777; married Sarah Aspinwall. Children were:
