Roger Pemberton (I.) of St. Albans, born about 1556; mar. lic. 6 May 1579; High Sheriff Herts 1618; died 13 November, buried at St. Peter's, St Albans, 20 November 1627. Will dated 13 November 1624; proved 5 December 1627 (P.C.C., 117, Skinner). Founder of St. Alban's Almshouses, still existing.	=Elizabeth, dau. of Ralph Moore of St. Albans, gent.; baptized at the Abbey 18 March 1564-5; buried at St. Peter's, St. Albaus, 15 July 1645.

Proc., Collins, Bdle. 218; supposed to be the one of this name at Nevis 1677-8; died s.p.	=Rebecca, dau. of John Pym of Brill, co. Bucks, and widow of Robert Pleydell; buried at Brill 29 October 1668.

Buried "in y <sup>e</sup> Library behind y <sup>e</sup> Altar."	=Rebecca, dau. of Robert and Mary Holmes; born about 1658; died 18 December 1712, aged 54; buried at Peterborough Cathedral 21 December 1712, "behind Altar." Will dated 6 May 1712; proved 1713 (P.C.C., 88, Leeds). M.I. on floor of north choir aisle. 2nd wife.
