

NEVIS. COMMON RECORDS, 1741—1750, p. 323.

Indenture dated 14 May 1750.

Between Roger Pemberton, Esq., and Mary his wife, and John Brown Smith, Gent., all of Nevis, of the one part, and Christopher Wilkinson of Nevis, Planter, of the other part.

In consideration of the sum of 5/- paid to them by the said Christopher Wilkinson, the said parties of the first part sell to him 50 acres of land in St John's parish [boundaries described] to have and to hold to the said Christopher, his heirs, Executors, etc., for one year at a rent of one peppercorn.

Indenture dated 19 Sep. 1750, between Roger Pemberton of Nevis, Esq., and William Pemberton, his "son and heir."

In consideration of the sum of 5/- paid by the said William Pemberton, the said Roger Pemberton conveys to him, his heirs and assigns for ever, a messuage in Charlestown in the island of Nevis, commonly known as Roger Pemberton's store or tenement, and all buildings thereto appertaining.
