Will of Sarah Pemberton, spinster, of parish of S. George, Nevis, dated 4 September 1773.

"Whereas my mother Elizabeth Pemberton, widow and relict of Robert Pemberton, senior, late of the parish aforesaid in the Island aforesaid, did by her last Will and Testament give and bequeath unto me the sum of £600 current money of the Island aforesaid to be paid in the space of 4 years after her death, [? as] reference to the said Will of my said mother Elizabeth Pemberton being had will more fully and at large appear, I do hereby give the said legacy of £600 . . . and all interest now due or which may hereafter be due thereupon, unto my
